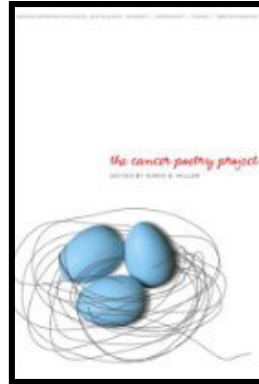
The Cancer Project: Poems by Cancer Patients and Those Who Love Them
